Accreditation Process Works

Phase One | Initial Request to Form a New School

Provision of Community Language School Guidelines and Invitation to participate in a New School initial meeting.

Estimated Time: up to 2 weeks.

Phase Three | New School Curriculum Development

Meet with School Teaching team for a curriculum design session and Curriculum Mentoring from CLSSA Education Team.

Estimated Time: 4 to 24 weeks.

Phase Five | New School Department Application

Submission of documentation to the Department and Launch and Celebration of New School Formation.

Estimated Time: 3 to 6 weeks.

Phase Two | New School Initial Meeting

Explore the language and cultural focus of the new School and discuss the requirements and documentation for forming a new School.

Estimated Time: 4 to 6 weeks.

Phase Four | New School First Term Operations

Meet with Host School Provider or Tour or School Facilities and Soft Launch of New School for initial operation period of the school for one term.

Estimated Time: 10 weeks.
